At Rainier Guest Services, LLC our mission is to provide quality products and services to our guests and visitors in a manner which preserves the environment.



## The following is a quick glimpse at our accomplishments for 2017



- Over 60,000 pounds of commingle recycling was diverted from the landfill.
- 561 gallons of cooking oil was recycled by turning it into Biodiesel
  - 79 pounds of ink cartridges were recycled
- 103 pounds of batteries were recycled
  - 90 pounds of fluorescent light bulbs were recycled





- 22,920 pounds of food scraps were composted
  - 665 pounds of used clothing/bedding and used amenities were donated to a local homeless shelter.
- 465 pounds of scrap metal was recycled.
  - 1,224 pounds of items were repurposed/reused.
  - Over 23% of total waste was diverted or recycled in 2017


## **Water Hydration Stations**

In 2015 we finished installation of 3 hydration stations in 3 different locations

 In 2017 almost 70,000 bottles were filled at the stations

Disposable water bottles were not sold in 2017.





## **Propane Vehicles**

In 2015 we replaced 4 of our transportation vans and one maintenance truck with LPG operated vehicles.



- Propane burns cleaner than gasoline or diesel
- Emissions were reduced by approximately 20,500 pounds of CO2
